Parent's Code Of Conduct

- I will be responsible for my behavior, as well as those who attend either a game or practice as my guest.
- I will provide positive support, care and encouragement for my child participating in MG Youth Football, by following the Parent's Code Of Conduct.
- I will encourage good sportsmanship by demonstrating positive support for all players, coaches and officials at every game and practice.
- I will place the emotional and physical well-being of my child ahead of a personal desire to win.
- I understand that practice time will equate to playing time.
- I will remain in the spectator area during games and practices.
- I will support coaches and officials working with my child, in order to encourage a positive and enjoyable experience for all.
- I will show respect for all participants at all times.
- I will be in control of my emotions.
- I will not make insulting comments to players, parents, officials or coaches of either team.
- I will not coach my child during the game or practice.
- I will not advise the coach how to do their job.
- I will accept the decisions of officials on the field as being fair, and called to the best of their ability.
- I will ask my child to treat other players, coaches, fans and officials with respect, regardless of race, sex, creed or ability.
- I will support the coaches, players, and officials, and help them teach the value of commitment to the team, sportsmanship, ethical conduct, and fair play.
- I will let my player know that school and education take priority over football.
- I have the ability to tell the coach if my player is NOT allowed to play.
- In the event that constructive feedback would like to be given, it will be done during a private moment, never in front of players, parents, officials or other spectators. These occurrences will take place in person, in the presence of another coach or a MG Youth Football board member, and never in email or written form. *A 24 hour waiting period after a game will be observed.*

I understand that any inappropriate behavior at games or practice, could be cause for ejection from the event. Failure to abide by the Parents Code Of Conduct will be subject to disciplinary action by the Monona Grove Youth Football Board of Directors.
